## Nadrasca

Nadrasca was established in 1967, as a Not-For-Profit Disability Service organisation and today provides support services to over 350 people with a disability across 22 locations in the Eastern suburbs of Melbourne.

## Community Options

### Nadrasca Community Options

Nadrasca Community Options provides support to people to pursue their individual goals and aspirations, and provides assistance to link people into their local community, while pursuing vocational, educational or recreational opportunities. We provide varied recreational & sporting activities, employment and volunteering opportunities, learning and life experiences.

### Community Activities

We encourage the people we support to get involved in their community by actively engaging in sports, health and social activities at a variety of locations. This enables people to develop skills to live as independently as possible, with appropriate support. We typically provide group-based activities.



### Education/Training

Accredited training will be offered in the format of Foundation courses at Certificate 1 level. This is offered in partnership with Box Hill Institute. The courses that we currently offer are:

- 22301VIC Certificate 1 in Transition Education
- 22302VIC Certificate 1 in Work Education.

We also offer non-accredited courses in life skills.

### Eligibility Criteria

To participate in Community Options, you need to be:

- A Participant with the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) or
- 18 years and over and registered for funding with the Department of Health & Human Services (DHHS)

If you are unsure about your status, please contact us for clarification.

### Fees

A fee for transport (where provided) will be charged, based on the individual's NDIS Service Agreement with Nadrasca.

All fees are reviewed annually, in line with the Consumer Price Index.
