# THE NADRASCA FARM

People with a Disability



## Nadrasca

---

Nadrasca was established in 1967, as a community-based Not-For-Profit Disability Service organisation and today provides support services to over 350 people living with a disability, across 22 locations in the Eastern suburbs of Melbourne.

The Nadrasca Organisational Values are: *Trustworthy, Caring, Respectful and Supportive.*

## The Nadrasca Farm

Nadrasca has developed a vision of excellence to deliver services that incorporate employment opportunities, training, community partnerships and community inclusions.

The Nadrasca Farm is on 3.5ha of land in Vermont, surrounded by residential properties.

The farm setting has provided and enabled opportunities for people in the community who have a physical, intellectual or sensory disability to partner with and access local community groups, while people from the local area benefit from the interaction with persons with a disability.

The Farm focuses on using recycled building products in the construction of ramps, fences and toilets. The Farm has 3 water tanks with a total capacity of 60,200 litres and 8 Solar Power Panels.

We grow organic vegetables – for cooking programmes and the participants take them home for their families.



Nadrasca has fostered partnerships with local businesses and community groups who support the Nadrasca Farm in a variety of ways, as well as with groups who have benefits from participating in the activities at the Farm.

External groups that access the Farm work in conjunction with the Farm to build garden beds and plant their own vegetables and implement different projects around the Farm.

Members of the Whitehorse Community have attended our Open days, which allow us to showcase what we do and the opportunities we can offer. This is empowering, highlighting the value that people with all abilities can and do contribute to the community in a valued way. The Farm is more of a Community Farm than simply a site of Nadrasca and is a good example of reverse integration.

## Eligibility Criteria

---

To participate at the Farm, you need to be:

- 18 years and over and registered for funding with the Department of Health & Human Services (DHHS) or
- A Participant with the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS)

If you are unsure about your status, please contact us for clarification.

## Fees

---

A fee for consumables will be charged by Nadrasca, based on the Plan chosen by the individual.

A fee for transport (where provided) will be charged, based on the individual's NDIS Service Agreement with Nadrasca.

All fees are reviewed annually, in line with the Consumer Price Index.
